






The data revolution





The Edge
Deloitte's Amsterdam HQ

- 30,000 sensors
- 6,800 LED lights powered through low-voltage Ethernet cables with sensors
- BMS uses sensors' data to adjust lighting and heating
- One of world's most sustainable office buildings
- Staff locate colleagues via an app



Majunga Tower La Defense, Paris

- Lighting and temperature controlled by users via mobile app
- Building occupancy tracked in real time through staff badges
- Information used to track empty meeting rooms





Cairo has **less than 1 million sqm** of office space – relatively small for a city of its size




Despite challenging conditions – quality office stock has **increased by 21%** over past 5 years




Most office activities still undertaken from older or secondary quality space




Potential for BTS projects and further upgrading as new supply is delivered over next 2 years




Major Office Projects | Greater Cairo








Globally

- Responsive place-making














Challenges and constraints



Occupiers

- Cost burden
- Turbulent market conditions
- Increase in price sensitivity
- Time & resources required to Infuse innovation into the operational framework



Investors

- Lack of demand on behalf of occupiers facing troubled market conditions
- Import Bans/high costs
- Lack of local input substitutes
- The time needed to Infuse new technology into a resisting market
- Lack of regulatory agencies' support
